New hydraulic tester with iPhone[™] App saves time by emailing a test certificate while in the field

The report generated by the smartphone App is in a "pdf" format meaning the data presented cannot be edited and can therefore be trusted as an accurate representation of the state of the machine at that moment in time.

The DHM testers combine ease-of-use with professional reporting providing an affordable and time-saving solution for the busy hydraulic service engineer. With the ability to measure flow rates of up to 400 / 800 lpm at up to 420Bar / 480 bar these new battery powered testers are ideally suited to field based testing of many agricultural and construction equipment systems. For fleet managers, the hydraulic test certificates produced by the DHM could also form part of a preventative maintenance program to reduce the occurrences of costly failures on site.
